

AWARDED SCHOLARSHIP

Charles Lewis Hoskins, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Roosevelt Bynum, 620 N 23rd Street. East St. Louis, is the recipient of several distinct honors.

Charles, presently a senior at East St. Louis Senior High School shall graduate in June. Charles is an active member of the school Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta national high school and junior college mathematics club, from which he received a trophy in competition in 1972 and again in 1973. He was also featured in Who's Who American High School Students, a recognition award for his leadership in academics, activities or community service in the book. Less than two percent of the junior class students nation-wide are awarded this recognition.
